2006 COMMUNITY SERVICE (CS) TEAM AGREEMENT

The purpose of this contract is to establish expectations for the Summit Velo community service team and promote team unity by having standards for all team members.

Summit Velo's vision is to encourage cycling through the spirit of competition and through reaching out to the community. We want people who are enthusiastic about cycling and want to give back to the cycling community, not necessarily just good racers interested in winning.

Although we are very excited about continuing the high standards that have been set in the past, we would like to provide an opportunity for people who have an interest in getting more involved in not only racing, but also the community as a whole. The purpose of the Summit Velo 4/5 Community Service (CS) team is to create an atmosphere in which racers can feel very comfortable with their abilities while providing an environment that encourages an increased involvement in the cycling community.

You are very important to Summit Velo. You will be representing us on the cycling scene and in our community. Summit Velo racers and volunteers will set the highest standards of sportsmanship and team cooperation within the racing community.

Please note that in the event that you upgrade to a Cat 3, it does not mean that Summit Velo automatically sponsors you as a Cat 3. That decision will be weighed based on your community service, your teamwork, as well as funding and may not come into play until the following year.

Community Service Team benefits:

- Cost + 10% deal at Absolute Bikes, Flagstaff and Sabino Cycles, Tucson.
- 1 jersey,
- 1 bib short,
- 2 pair socks
- You are responsible for the cost of any additional clothing you order.

Community Service Team must meet the following requirements:

- Pay \$30 club fee to join.
- Volunteer for at least 40 hours of approved community service activities as outlined below. Summit Velo jersey or other identifying clothing must be worn during all community service events.
- Participate in at least 5 USCF races in the calendar year from the list of Summit Velo qualified races.
- Be an active member of our local cycling community above and beyond agreed upon volunteer hours. For example, participate in group rides, Bide to Work Week, etc. Please note that the aforementioned activities do not necessarily constitute approved community service hours.

- Always wear a helmet while cycling, obey all traffic laws, represent and support our sponsors responsibly!
